

# The Hallmark of Jacob's Descendants

***For the gifts and the calling of God are irrevocable*** (Romans 11:29; NKJV used throughout unless otherwise noted; emphasis added).

Many of these promises were given to Jacob, who had twelve sons. Following Jacob's death, these promises passed to his sons and their descendants; some of which are laid out in Genesis 49:1-28, and Deuteronomy 33:6-29. With these promises also comes responsibility.

***For everyone to whom much is given, from him much will be required; and to whom much has been committed, of him they will ask more*** (Luke 12:48b; emphasis added).

The greatest single responsibility given to Jacob and his descendants involved teaching all nations on earth about God's law and commandments, and if they failed there would be consequences:

***For thus says the Lord: 'We have heard a voice of trembling, of fear, and not of peace. Ask now, and see, whether a man is ever in labor with child? So why do I see every man with his hands on his loins like a woman in labor, and all faces turned pale?***

***Alas! For that day is great, so that none is like it; and it is the time of Jacob's trouble'*** (Jeremiah 30:5-7).

***For I am with you, says the Lord, to save you; though I make a full end of all nations where I have scattered you, yet I will not make a complete end of you. But I will correct you in justice, and will not let you go altogether unpunished*** (Jeremiah 30:11; emphasis added).

If there is one characteristic that identifies the descendants of Jacob today, what would it be? ***And you, Ezekiel, take a sharp sword, use it as a barber's razor, and pass it over your head and your beard; then take balances to weigh and divide the hair. You shall burn with fire one-third in the midst of the city, when the days of the siege are finished; then you shall take one-third and strike around it with the sword, and one third you shall scatter in the wind: I will draw out a sword after them. You shall also take a small number of them and bind them in the edge of your garment. Then take some of them again and throw them into the midst of the fire, and burn them in the fire; for from there a fire will go out into all the house of Israel*** (Ezekiel 5:1-4).

And here is the crux of the problem, which we see occurring among Jacob's descendants today.

*She (Jacob's progeny) has rebelled against My judgments by doing wickedness **more than the** (other) **nations**, and against My statutes **more than the countries that are all around her**; for they have refused My judgments, and they have not walked in My statutes. Therefore thus says the Lord God: 'Because you have multiplied **disobedience more than the nations that are all around you**, and have not walked in My statutes, nor kept My judgments, **nor even done according to the judgments of the nations that are all around you**. Therefore, I am against you and will execute judgments in your midst in the sight of the nations. And **I will do among you what I have never done, and the like of which I will never do again, because of all your abominations** (Ezekiel 5:6-9; Ed. Notes in parentheses; emphasis added).*

So, when the leaders of Muslim countries call out western nations for their lawless conduct, and label them as "The Great Satan" is it any wonder? These same western nations have descendants of Jacob among them who commit heinous acts that are repulsive to these other countries. It's time for Jacob's modern-day descendants to cease and desist their lawless behavior before it's too late.
